

VINNIES BUSHFIRE APPEAL

"As bushfires continue to destroy homes across the Western Downs, St Vincent de Paul Society has <u>reinstated the Bushfire Appeal</u> to help those who have lost their homes and livelihoods in the blaze.

The funds raised from the Bushfire Appeal will help our Members and Volunteers as they continue to support fire-impacted Companions with their long-term recovery.

This is the second time this year the Western Downs region has been devastated by bushfires.

As many areas across Queensland are currently at a high fire risk, we are continuing to monitor the situation in case further support is needed in other regions.

Our teams in the Toowoomba and Brisbane Diocese are currently working together to continue assistance to fire-impacted families in the Western Downs.

Nearby Conferences in Dalby, Chinchilla, Miles and Toowoomba continue their support of families in impacted communities.

DECEMBER AND CHRISTMAS MASS TIMES

This year, Christmas Eve falls on a Sunday so on 24 December, the morning mass is 4th Sunday of Advent and then in the afternoon we celebrate Christmas Eve Vigil Mass.

As St Theresa's shares Fr. Brian with St Mary MacKillop Parish Highfields, some decisions needed to be made so that Fr. Brian did not exhaust himself over that weekend.

At our recent Parish Council meeting, it was decided, in consultation with Fr. Brian, that St Theresa's would have a Vigil Mass on 23 December and no morning mass on 24 December for the 4th Sunday of Advent. St Theresa's would then have a 6pm Vigil mass Christmas Eve and 8.30am Mass on Christmas Dav.

This will enable Fr. Brian to celebrate 8am Mass on Sunday 24 December at Highfields and then 4pm Christmas Eve vigil mass at Highfields before needing to drive into Toowoomba. Highfields will then have 7am Mass on Christmas day.
